Minutes of the Meeting with Parents of Classes PG to IX held on 06.02.2025,07.02.2025 and 11.02.2025.

List of parents present are in file with us. From the management Secretary, Vice- President, Treasurer and some MCM were present. Most of the Class Teachers (as applicable). TR & others were also present.

The meeting started with the General Secretary of MCM inviting the Principal to take charge of the meeting.

The following points were discussed:

 NEP 2020: The meaning and effect of the same was explained in brief. Changes in methodology of teaching, question paper pattern (Concept based education), importance of co-curricular activities, participation in any two clubs of which one must be a component of English, introduction of two working Saturdays, an example of model question, holistic Report Card were all explained in detail and with lively examples.

All the above are expected to begin from the next session.

It was also announced that a minimum of 10 to 20 minutes time will be increased as working period on all working days to cope with the latest changes and to fulfil the NEP guidelines.

Introduction of Online Payment of Fees and ERP System to get started from 01.04.2025 and if not latest by 15.05.2025. The Principal promised one theory and one practical class per week on computers . Practical classes on Science based subjects will also increase as per requirement.

Principal assured the parents that they will once again be invited to attend sessions on ERP from experts and that attendance will be mandatory. The Principal expressed his love, affection, respect for all his parents and even thanked each one of them for active participation in the meeting barring class 9.

He also explained the selection criteria for availing of Science Stream in class 9.

He also emphasised that promotion from class 5 to 6 and 8 to 9 will be very strict and will follow the promotion criteria. The promotion criteria for class VIII was again highlighted .
